



1. EU Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) Regulation (EU) 2019/1021

The EU POPs Regulation aims to eliminate the use of chemicals which are persistent in nature and pose adverse risk to human health and the environment. The regulation transposes the Stockholm Convention and Aarhus protocol into EU law and restricts/prohibits production, placing on the market and use of POPs, as well as other mitigation measures.
